'As of 2023, there are 740 branded residence schemes in operation globally, totalling more than 100,000 units – an increase from 580 in 2021,' says Charlotte Williams of Savills. 'The rise shows outstanding demand as well as growing interest from operators,

brands, investors and developers. In future, this market is set to comprise over 1,100 schemes, not counting those that are yet to be announced.'

She also points out how this trend isn't confined to any particular city or continent – indeed, quite the contrary. 'Year by year we see new locations entering the market. For example, countries such as Jamaica, Nigeria, Oman and Pakistan all have projects




